SUBJECT: Ordinance Making Additional Appropriations for Fiscal Year 2021 for General Fund (Grants, State Aid and Donations)

Attached is an appropriation for City Council's consideration for Fiscal Year 2021 additional revenues for various departments within the General Fund.

- The Fire Department received a 2020 Local Emergency Management Performance Grant (LEMPG) through the Virginia Department of Emergency Management in the amount of \$7,500. The grant has a local match equal to the award which the current appropriated budget accounts for the local match piece; this ordinance appropriates the grant funds of \$7,500 to the General Fund.
- The Fire Department received an allocation of funds from the Fiscal Year 2021 Fire Program Fund from the Virginia Department of Fire Programs. The funds can be used for training, equipment and supplies for firefighting and personal protective equipment. This ordinance appropriates the state grant of \$46,304 to the Fire Department for the above stated use.
- The Finance Department has received a grant from the Virginia Risk Sharing Association of \$4,000. The grant has been used to purchase CR2 defibrillators at City Hall and Municipal Building. This ordinance appropriates the grant funds to the contingency account for the above stated use.
- The Police Department has received additional donations during the fiscal year in the amount of \$325. The donations were received for crime prevention. This ordinance appropriates the donations to the Police Department for the above stated use.
- The Library Department received additional donations during the fiscal year in the amount of \$690. This ordinance appropriates the donations to the Library Department.
- The Library Department has received the final state aid amount from the Library of Virginia and an additional \$7,110 needs to be appropriated to increase the budget for the year. The state aid will be applied to audio visual materials. This ordinance appropriates the additional state aid that has been approved to the Library for the above stated use.

WHEREAS, the City has received a 2020 Local Emergency Management Performance Grant (LEMPG) through the Virginia Department of Emergency Management in the amount of \$7,500, and

WHEREAS, the City has received an allocation of funds from the Fiscal Year 2021 Fire Program Grant Fund through the Virginia Department of Fire Programs in the amount of \$46,304, and

WHEREAS, the City has received a grant from the Virginia Risk Sharing Association in the amount of \$4,000, and

WHEREAS, the City received additional State Aid from the Library of Virginia in the amount of \$7,110, and

WHEREAS, the City received additional donations in the amount of \$1,015 for the Police Department and Library Department, and

WHEREAS, the City has additional needs to be appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Poquoson, Virginia:

Section 1: That an additional \$65,929 in revenues in the General Fund be and the same hereby are appropriated within the Fiscal Year 2021 Budget as follows:
