Please be advised that, effective immediately, the City of Poquoson will consider uniformly graded aggregate drives to be 50% impervious. In order to qualify for this impervious rate in stormwater calculations, the aggregate must:

- Be uniformly graded, with little to no fines. Well graded aggregates or aggregates with minimal to no in-place void ratios will continue to be considered impervious.
- Be designed and constructed with an underlayment of filter fabric. A graduated aggregate subgrade designed to prevent fines migration may be substituted for the filter fabric, subject to approval by the City Engineer.
- Be loosely compacted.
