

The Poquoson City Electoral Board met on Thursday, May 09, 2024, in Council Chambers, 500 City Hall Avenue, Poquoson, Virginia.

Present were Lewis Littlepage, Chairman; Jennifer Barnes, Vice Chairman; Lynn Pauls, Secretary; Tammy Pinckney, General Registrar and Director of Elections and Tara Moore, Deputy Registrar.

Chairman Littlepage called the meeting to order at 12:30PM.

Registrar Pinckney reported to the Board about her investigation into moving the Central Absentee Precinct (CAP) from the Western Precinct to the General Registrars Office. This would save resources and time for Election Officials and the Registrar's office. The process would involve a public comment period; a public hearing and approval from the Attorney General's office. The Board is taking this under advisement.

She reminded the Board to be available during the week of November 18, 2024, to participate in the Risk Limiting Audit for the US Senate Election.

There was a discussion about setting up the ballot scanner and how it should be done. Vice Chairman Barnes made a motion to include a demonstration at the school of instructions. The motion was seconded by Chairman Littlepage.
