

The Electoral Board for The City of Poquoson met on Monday, March 17, 2025, in the City Council Conference Room, 500 city Hall Avenue, Poquoson, Virginia.

Present were Lewis Littlepage, Chairman; Jennifer Barnes, Vice Chairman; Lynn Pauls, Secretary; Tammi Pinckney, General Registrar and Director of Elections and Tara Moore, Deputy Registrar.

Chairman Littlepage called the meeting to order at 10:00AM.

Eric Vaudt, Pastor at Tabernacle United Methodist Church, was in attendance to address the Board about a scheduling conflict. Primary for State Offices, (if held) will be on June 17th. This conflicts with the church activities that week.

After discussion, the Pastor agreed to cancel the church activities on June 17.

In return Electoral Board will set up polls after 8:00 P.M. on Monday June 16th.

The Deputy Registrar reported that 232 inactive voters were cancelled on March 12, 2025 as required by § 24.2-428.2 of the Code of Virginia and in compliance With the National Voter Registration Act (NVRA), 52 USC § 20501 *et seq.* These Voters were placed into “Inactive” status on or before August 10, 2022, did not Respond to multiple notices, and have not voted in any election or updated their Voter registration between August 10, 2022 and January 22, 2025.

Registrar Pinckney informed the Board that the filing deadline for candidates to appear on the ballot for the June 17, 2025 primary election is April 14th. Her office is making preliminary preparations. She advised the Board to schedule a meeting to conduct L&A testing and to determine the number of ballots to be ordered.

The Board unanimously agreed to reappoint Machine Custodians, Alex Pinckney (poll books) and Dennis Pryor (scanners) for the year 2025. Tara Moore, Deputy Registrar, will also serve as Machine Custodian.

The next meeting of the Electoral Board will be held on Thursday, April 10, 2025 at 1:30PM.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:28 AM.
